[The setting is at the bottom of the sea. The weather is stormy, so the Narrator is standing between the moving Waves.]

**Narrator**: One windy day in stormy weather,

[All of the sea creatures enter the stage, run around in a circle and settle down in a semicircle, facing the audience. The **Waves** surround the sea creatures, moving like water, representing the stormy weather.]

**Narrator:** The Shark was first to face the crowd,

It shouted out very loud...

[Shark moves into the center of the semicircle, looking very powerful and scary.]

**Shark:** I shall be king to rule the sea,

I am the scariest, you see.

I have more teeth than anyone you know,

And I can swallow anybody whole!

**Narrator**: The Shrimp jumped in

And added in...

[Shrimp comes jumping in as the Narrator speaks. Shark moves back to its place in the semicircle.]

**Shrimp:** I know you're very vicious,

But I'm the most delicious. If anyone should rule the sea, It definitely should be me!

**Narrator**: The Clownfish came tumbling in,

It had some seaweed on its fin.

[Clownfish tumbles in, looks clumsy, and has some green seaweed stuck to its body. Shrimp moves back to its place in the semicircle.]

**Clownfish**: Yes, Shrimp, you are so very yummy,

But I should rule because I'm funny! Without me the sea would fall to sadness, Without me there simply would be madness!

[Octopus enters the center, waving its tentacles around. Clownfish moves back to its place in the semicircle.]

Octopus: Yes, you are funny, it is true,

But I've more tentacles than you. With all the arms and legs I have, I'll rule the sea like no one had!
