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<u>CAST</u>: Narrator Little Red Walking Hood Mother Granny Wolf Cop

<u>PROPS</u>: Red cape, covered basket, pistol for Red. Apron & wooden spoon for Mother. Long nightdress and bonnet for Granny. Wolf mask. Police cap, gun & handcuffs for Cop. Chair

NARRATOR: Once upon a time there lived a girl named Little Red Walking Hood who lived with her mother in a small cottage. Frankly, I'd prefer a castle.

LITTLE RED: (Snotty) We didn't ASK for your opinion.

(Mother enters stage carrying basket)

MOTHER: Little Red, please take these goodies to Granny's house – even though there's a mean, vicious wolf between here and there.

LITTLE RED: I don't know, Mother. This smacks of child abuse to me.

MOTHER: (holding wooden spoon in the air) I'll show you child abuse!

LITTLE RED: Er, just kidding, Mother. What time do you want me back?

MOTHER: How about a year from now?

LITTLE RED: Okay. Catch ya later. (Grabs basket and leaves)

NARRATOR: Little Red didn't get far before she came upon a vicious wolf.

WOLF: (Jumps in front of Little Red) Boo.

LITTLE RED: That was lame. Is that the best you can do?

WOLF: (digusted) Yeah, for the pay I get. Say, why don't you hire me to escort you to Granny's?

RED: How did you know where I'm going?

WOLF: Educated guess.

RED: I'd hire you but I'm fresh out of cash. Do you take VISA?

WOLF: Not. (Pause) Okay, well, see you around.

(Riding Hood exits stage. Wolf sneaks to Granny's shack and knocks on door)
