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GETTIN' HITCHED

CAST: Old Man, Old Woman, Kid 1, Kid 2, Pharmacist, Minister, Cryer, Organist

PROPS: Bench, 2 canes, gray wigs, long beard, old folks costumes, lab coat, black robe, black suit coat with white shirt and clerical collar

(Old Man & Woman seated on bench. Dub in painful rendition of "Wedding March".)

OLD MAN: Sophie, we've known each other 80 years. Let's get married.

OLD WOMAN: (hand to ear) BURIED?

OLD MAN: No, no, no. MARRIED.

OLD WOMAN: Well, it's about time, Clarence.

MINISTER (enters stage) Congratulations! I'll sign you up for marriage classes.

OLD MAN: Given our age, you'd better make it a crash course.

(All exit stage. Someone moves bench. Pharmacist, Kids 1 & 2 enter Stage Right.)

KID 1: Can you believe that Great, Great Uncle Clarence is finally getting married?

KID 2: Yeah, hey? How old is he anyway?

KID 1: 95.

KID 2: Let's hope it's a short engagement.

(Kids 1 and 2 approach Pharmacist)

PHARMACIST: (smiling) May I help you?

KID 1: Yes. Do you sell bedpans at this pharmacy?
